Our Prevention Coordinators can assist your school or organization to:

- Identify the needs of the youth you serve.
- Review your existing sexuality education program or curriculum.
- Select an evidence-based program that meets the needs of the youth you serve and fits with your school or community environment.
- Purchase selected programs or curricula, along with the materials needed to effectively implement them.
- Provide training and ongoing technical assistance to staff in delivering an evidence-based program or curriculum.
- Ensure the curriculum is carried out successfully, resulting in positive behavior changes among the participants.
- Develop a plan for gaining support for your program in your school or community and for responding to resistance or controversy.
- Link you to resources in your community to address teen pregnancy, HIV and STI prevention.
- Align your program or curriculum to meet Maine's Learning Results and the National Sexuality Education Standards, K-12.
