

“Out of Order”

Grade: 9-12th

Objective: Demonstrate that not everyone likes the same things and there is no particular order that needs to occur within sexual activity.

Procedure:

1. Print out each choice on individual pieces of paper.
2. Break students into groups and give each group a set of questions.
3. Ask students to place options in the correct order.

Process:

Compare orders between groups.

Discussion Questions:

1. Why did your team choose the order it did?
2. Is there a certain order you need to follow with more intimate activities?
3. What is a consensual way to introduce new sexual activities?
