WHY WE STARTED THIS WORK

#### 1 in 4 Girls + 1 in 6 Boys

Experience sexual abuse during their childhood.

#### 81% of young people

Experience some form of sexual harassment by the time they finish **secondary school.** 

#### **1 in 2 Rape Victims**

Is under the age of **EIGHTEEN** and **1 in 6 are under the age of TWELVE**.

#### **12% of transgender youth**

report being sexually assaulted in K–12 settings by peers or educational staff
